

# **CUHS SCHOLARSHIPS COMMON APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

**STEP ONE: Download this form and complete this application using the downloaded form.**

## **What Scholarships are Included in the Application?**

This application applies to scholarships managed by the Corning Union High School District including several endowments and the Rodgers Ranch Scholarships. It also applies to those organizations who have designated Corning Union High School to select the scholarship recipient while they will oversee the distribution of scholarship funds. These organizations include, but are not limited to, Corning Rotary, Corning Exchange Club, and Corning Eyecare Center.

The application does not include other school related awards such as CSF, ASB, Cardinal Nest, CUHS Employees, or other organization specific scholarships.

## **Who Should Complete This Application?**

Any student planning to attend a two or four-year college or university should complete this scholarship. Students planning to attend a technical/vocational school that separates their instruction into semesters may also apply for these scholarships. Persons planning to go directly into the workforce or into the military should not complete this application.

## **Where do I Save This Form?**

Save your working copy onto the device you will use to work on this form. If you plan to work on the form in the library, B-1 lab, B-6 lab, or a school provided Chromebook, save the file to your school provided directory. If you have cloud storage, you can save it to your cloud account. If you use a personal computer, download the application to your computer. Make sure to include your name as part of the file name.

## **Can I Expand the Response Boxes?**

No. The response boxes are fixed length. Be thorough but succinct. Although not recommended, you may attach additional sheets.

## **Do I Need to Attach Proof of Acceptance, Scores, Awards, etc.?**

No, in fact, it is better not to because it makes distribution and review much more difficult for the Scholarship Committee.

## **Do I Have to Use This Form?**

Yes, all responses must be typed. If you do not have computer access or the ability to use the PDF form, you can get a paper copy from the Career Center and type the information using the typewriters in the Career Center.

## **How and When do I Submit the Application?**

Print the application and turn it in to the Career Center no later than 8:00 AM on the Monday before the Spring Break.
