- Any person or entity operating drone shall agree to hold the district harmless from any claims of harm to individuals or property resulting from the operation of the drone and provide proof of adequate liability covering such use.
- The operator is responsible for complying with applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations, including federal safety regulations pursuant to 14 CFR 107.15-107.51 with include, but are not limited to, requirements that the drone not be flown at night, above 400 feet in altitude, or over any people unless they are in a covered structure or stationary vehicle. The operator shall maintain the visual sight with the drone at all times.
- The drone shall be kept away from any area reasonably considered private, including but not limited to, restrooms, locker rooms, and individual homes.
- The district reserves the right to rescind the authorization for use of drones at any time.
